Established in 1974 with the goal of providing education and professional networking. ARN offers its members many benefits including: Annual Education Conferences, Rehabilitation Nursing, Leadership Courses/Programs, Rehabilitation Nursing Journal; ARN News, & Certification to name but a few.

ARN has more than 75 chapters, throughout the United States, which offer local educational opportunities and networking.
